3. All Advisory Committee members will be invited and eligible for reimbursement for participation on Monday and Tuesday

4. The Management Committee members who are not in categories 1, 2 or 3 are considered not to be active WG members and will be invited and eligible for reimbursement for participation <u>only for Tuesday</u> (which means they will still be able to claim 2 nights and arrive on Monday morning and leave on Wednesday afternoon evening, but will be eligible for three nights less - 2 instead of 5 - and accordingly will be eligible for less meals).

5. MC substitutes and WG members not in categories 1-4 will be invited and reimbursed only if there are free spaces available after inviting individuals from the above categories, and will be invited on a rolling basis giving priority to Early Career Investigators, participants from Inclusiveness Target Countries, and participants from non-academic organisations. Strategic considerations of value of participation will be applied on a case by case basis.
